Y1 T1	Did you make sure that everyone had a chance to say what they wanted to, maybe asking a question, or answering one? Did you all take turns?	
Y1 T2	Before you started, did you talk to each other about what you were going to do? Did everyone listen to what other people said?	
Y1 T3	Did you have a chance to tell the group what you thought and why you thought that? Did you decide together how you were going to tell the rest of the class what you did in the group?	
Y2 T1	Did everyone listen to what other people thought and what they would like to do? Did you agree together what each person had to do next?	
Y2 T2	Did you think about different ways of doing things and agree on the best one?	
Y2 T3	Did you feel OK to ask a question if you didn't understand? Did people say if they agreed with or liked something someone said or did?

Y3 T1	At the beginning of the activity did you take some time to talk about what needed to be done, and who would do what in the group?	Very well So-so Not very well

Y5 T2	When you needed to make a decision in the group, did you think about the consequences of each possibility? Did you make sure everyone had a say? Were you able to reach a compromise when people had different ideas?	Very well So-so Not very well
Y5 T3	Did you have a leader of the group? Did you agree what the leader of the group should do – for example, encouraging others and making sure that everyone has a turn and deciding what to do when people can't agree?	Very well So-so Not very well
Y6 T1	If you did not understand something, did it feel OK to ask the person to explain again? Did you say if you did not agree with something and did you have a chance to explain why? If someone said they didn't agree with what someone else said or did, did that person ask them why and listen to their reasons? Did it feel OK for people in the group to disagree? Y6 T2	Did you use 'peaceful problem-solving' to try to find a win-win solution if people didn't agree in the group? Did the language you used and the way people said things to each other make a good solution more likely?	Very well So-so Not very well
